BEER and WINE Tasting and Judging at the Milton Show;

John Hozack gave a brief history of the tasting and judging at the Show which started in 154 years ago, John had a booklet of the 100 years anniversary show, John has been involved since 1997. There are seven beer judges and John Payne is the chief wine judge, there are two wine judges. John would like our club to be more involved with the show.

Wayne Fry talked about the different beer categories and what judges check such as appearance, aroma, taste, mouth fullness, bitterness and after taste. President Bernard and guest Greg Ryan tasted a commercial beer and gave their judgement.

John Payne has been wine tasting since 1977; John said that screw top wine bottles can last for a few days, compared with cork bottle which only lasts for a day. In judging you get a 20ml of wine to taste, which lets the judge to get three mouthfuls, one looks for the spectrum, smell, taste and feel in the mouth after swallowing.

Dom Fondacaro won the raffle and **Yvonne Young** won the second prize.
