Meeting's report; 29 October 2024

Members and partner met at the Ulladulla Youth Centre, 80 St Vincents Street, Ulladulla, for a workplace visit.

Dean Naylor-Clark and **Peta Grinham** welcomed us a at their centre, they are both Youth Case Workers, the centre is funded by the Department of Communities and Justice (DCJ). Dean is completing a Bachelor of Youth Work.

The Ulladulla Youth Centre provides early intervention and place prevention for young people 12-18 years old and their families living in the Illawarra region. This service works with the local schools to help support young people in the community to remain and be supported at school and advice and assistance is provided to assist the young people to access the required services.

The Southern Shoalhaven Youth Services provides casework support, community outreach, incidental support for young people and families in crisis, after school drop-in program every Tuesday, group work programs in partnership with Ulladulla high school and free school holiday programs.

The Service works strongly with local schools and community organisations to help support young people in the community to remain safe, feel supported and receive the assistance they require.

The centre has a Youth Beat van to transport the students, say to the skate park, in the centre there is a multipurpose room with games, computers, outdoors they will have a basketball ring and they are in the process of getting a new kitchen and our club presented the centre with a donation of \$1,500 towards the kitchen and Bunnings is providing one at very reduced price.

Peta and Dean, on behalf of the Youths Centre, were very happy with our donation towards the new kitchen.

Thank you, **Bernard Jones** for the well BBQed sausages and onions, thank you **Yvonne Young** for organising the food; salads and sweets prepared by the Dunn Lewis Centre.

Youth Service Director Yvonne Young said our club is now sending two students to the RYLA week; Max Mollohan and Chloe Jeffers.
