Guest speaker Sophie Ray; Ben Hatcher introduced the Shoalhaven Education Fund program, and said that this program has been available in the Shoalhaven since 2012, is run by volunteer and is a not for profit program.

It all started in Boorowa, NSW, in 1993, when a group of community members came together to raise funds for students who couldn't afford post-school training or further education, that was the beginning of Country Education Foundation.

They provide funds/equipment to students for assistance with their tertiary studies; the Fund supports young people from the Shoalhaven with their costs of post-school education and training. This year it has helped 52 students from the Shoalhaven, that includes 20 from Milton/Ulladulla, total value of their grants; over \$153,000.

2013, 13 students from the Shoalhaven and included six from Milton/Ulladulla for a total of \$7,800.

Numerous of local fund recipients come back to our area to work.

Young people from 16- to 26-year-old can apply for financial support, they are interviewed and assessed, the support is for rent help, transport, laptop ... money given is from \$500 to \$5,000 and is spent under supervision.

Students can get matching funds from their university.

The Fund requires help through getting new volunteers for running the program or help with fundraising events; such as BBQs they also need donations; financial support.
