**John Payne** gave a resume on his life which started in Young. John also spoke on the RMB Band concert and the Lions Park.

**Peter Still and Tom O'Callahan** were our guest speakers, Tom spoke on the Cancer Support Foundation of Milton Ulladulla (CSF), (formerly the Cancer Outpatients Appeal), a community volunteer-based charity, committed to fundraising and advocating for the enhancement of the provision of cancer related clinical and support services, including palliative care, to residents of the Southern Shoalhaven.

The Cancer Outpatients was formed in 2003 to raise funds needed to establish and run a cancer care service in Milton. The centre provides chemotherapy, clinician rooms and a wide range of support services.

The Cancer Centre is staffed by Oncology Nurses who provide Chemotherapy and other intravenous services to patients three days a week. Patients are supported by a Social Worker who visits weekly.

In 2021 the name of the Cancer Outpatients Appeal of Milton Ulladulla Inc. was changed to the Cancer Support foundation of Milton Ulladulla Inc.

The CSF has the ability to support patients who were financially struggling during the treatment of their Cancer, or while in Palliative Care, with fuel and food vouchers. **Please spread the word and donations to CSF are tax deductible.**
