As in previous years NAIDOC the schools are involved and different community services, Paul has made a request for the Jumping Castle on Friday July 12, the festival to be held at the Ulladulla Civic Centre grounds. Apart from the NAIDOC festival the Lands Council is also working with younger Aboriginal people with camps including canoe making.

Youth Service Director Andrea Tucker announced that with the fine money that club members donated (**\$400**) for the Seven Women program will pay for one child to attend school for a year and includes meals and uniforms.
