Youth Report: Have received interest from a past High School student last year in attending next year's RYLA.

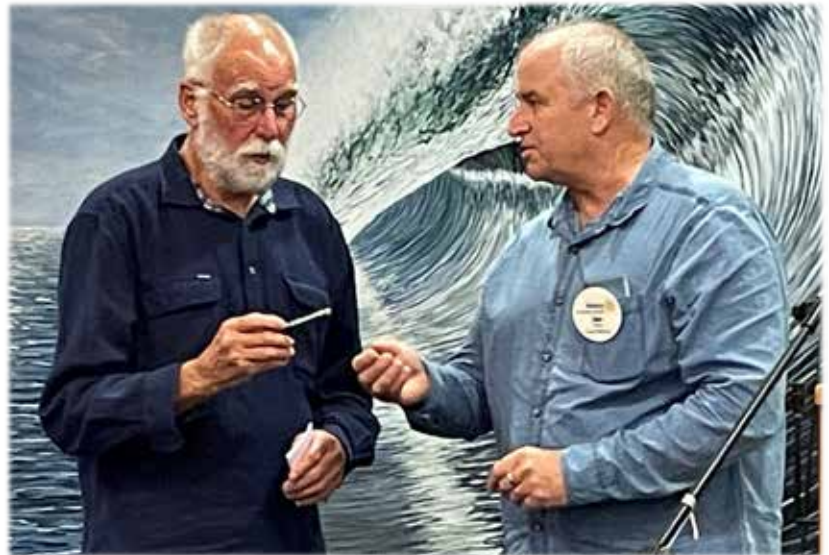
