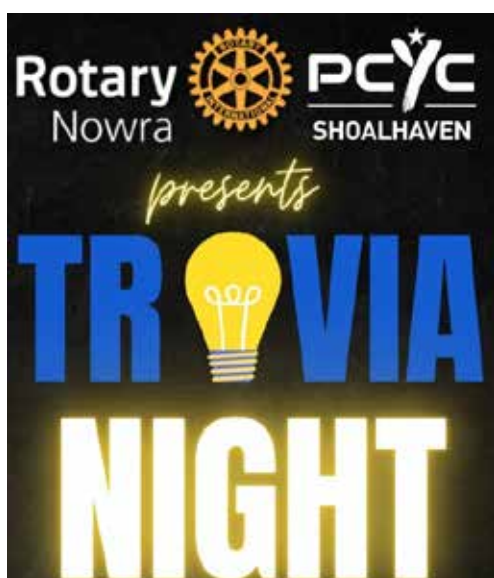
**Almoner Bill Harris** said that **Gordon Young** is still in hospital and **Maisie Bennett** is fine.
